Job responsibilities:

- Lead team to create Properties & Set Dressing for each production, in conjunction with Scenic Designer
- Supervise Prop Shop Assistant and Props Intern through all phases of process
- Creation of and management of Props Budget, in collaboration with Production Manager
- Manage purchasing of any items needed (in-store and online shopping)
- Manage props load-in and strike for each production
- Attends read throughs, run throughs, and production meetings as necessary
- Manage general maintenance of the shop and show maintenance through the run
- Evening show duties are assigned as each show demands. These include helping in our patron parking lots, ushering, bartending, concessions, etc.
