## Job responsibilities:

- Build scenery according to technical drawings and as directed by the Technical Director or Lead Carpenter
- Load-in and strike scenic elements for each production
- Secure and safe rigging of all scenery
- Assist the Lead Carpenter and Technical Director in maintaining safety in the scene shop and theater
- Work with scene shop interns and guide them through assigned projects
- Evening show duties are assigned as each show demands. These include helping in our patron parking lots, ushering, bartending, concessions, etc.

## Skills:

- Working knowledge of scenery construction with minimum one year experience
- Ability to handle fast-paced scenic builds, load-ins and strikes
- Ability to read and interpret construction drawings
- Knowledge and safe use of common stationary, pneumatic and power hand tools
- Excellent communication skills
- Ability to work at heights
- Ability to lift 75 lbs
- Understanding of theatrical practices
- Team-oriented attitude

- MIG welding experience
- Finish carpentry skills, including molding and trim work
- Intermediate rigging skills

Staff arrival date on campus is May 19<sup>th</sup> 2023. Departure date is either after the fifth show opens on September 5<sup>th</sup>, or after the final production closes and the property is closed down on October 23<sup>rd</sup>.

The rate for this position is \$500 - \$650 per week, based on skills and experience. Travel stipend provided. All positions are housed on property, at no cost. Meals are provided at a cost of \$85/week.
