- Schedule and attend costume fittings, in collaboration with Costume Designer and Stage Management
- Supervise Costume Technician and Costume Intern through all phases of process
- Provide learning opportunities to costume intern on a regular basis
- Guide costume intern with wardrobe paperwork and dresser duties, including quick-rigging and setting up of dressing rooms and quick-change areas
- Manage any fabric dying, clothing and shoe repair, costume crafts, and wig maintenance
