Job responsibilities:

- Work independently to cut and construct, as well as alter, costumes based on instruction from Costume Shop Supervisor and Costume Designer
- Attend fittings to assist and take notes for Shop Supervisor and Designer
- Load-in and strike wardrobe for each production
- Assist with fabric dying, clothing and shoe repair, costume crafts, and wig maintenance
- Assist with general maintenance of the shop and show maintenance through the run
- Assist with supervision and instruction of costume intern through all phases of process
- Help guide costume intern with wardrobe paperwork and dresser duties, including quick-rigging and setting up of dressing rooms and quick-change areas
- Willingly assist other departments as needed including projects related to the well being and maintenance of our property
- Evening show duties are assigned as each show demands. These include helping in our patron parking lots, ushering, bartending, concessions, etc.
