- Supervise Prop Shop Artisan and Props Intern through all phases of process

- Manage the pulling of hand props and furniture from stock
- Manage props load-in and strike for each production
- Manage general maintenance of the shop and show maintenance through the run

- Willingly assist other departments as needed including projects related to the well being and maintenance of our property
